The YHPA is excited to announce the new semester of the After-School Clubs to be offered at Yeshivat He'Atid in Spring 2018.

Spring 2018 clubs will begin on April 17 and run for 8 weeks until June 7 2018.

Please note that club spaces are limited, so please register as soon as possible.

Please pay attention to the grade requirements for each club when registering your children.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND POLICIES

Registration and Payment: *The registration information will be sent out on Monday, March 19 (around 9:00 PM).* Please complete the registration form in its entirety. For clubs that the YHPA collects payment, you will be able to add them to your cart and checkout. If a club requires you to register through their site, please fill out our registration form first and then click the link to register at the club's website. Registration must be accompanied by payment. Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis. We expect some clubs to fill up very quickly, so we are trying to give as much advance notice as possible of the registration date and time. If a club does not get the minimum number of children required to run, you will be notified via email and will have the option to enroll in a different club, based on availability. **PLEASE LOOK OVER THE CLUB CHOICES WITH YOUR CHILDREN TO MAKE SURE THAT THEY WANT TO ATTEND THE CLUBS YOU ARE REGISTERING THEM FOR.**

Club Fees: Please note that we negotiate the costs of clubs with the providers in order to bring them at the lowest. To further minimize the fees, all YHPA after-school clubs are run by volunteers. YHPA's goal is to help parents with the after-school enrichment for all Yeshivat He'Atid kids at the lowest fees!

Club Cancellations: From time to time, a personal issue may prevent an instructor from being able to come on a scheduled day. We will do our best to notify the parents involved as soon as possible. If the situation arises where an instructor does not show up, we will notify parents as soon as possible, but we will make sure that the affected children are kept entertained by the club monitor until they are picked up.

Refunds: A refund will be given only before the second club session. There will be no club refund after your child attends second club session.

All refund requests must be in writing prior to the 2nd class and there will be a \$25 processing fee per child. After 2nd class is completed, no refunds allowed. No exceptions.

All cancelation/refund requests must be in writing prior to 2nd class.

If your child is a discipline problem, the child can be removed from the program with no refund.

Absences: Due to the careful planning and scheduling of each club, there are no makeup classes for individual absences. Makeup classes will only be scheduled for cancelled classes.

Snacks: Since clubs will be starting after dismissal, children will have a short break between dismissal and the beginning of clubs. We strongly suggest that you send a small snack and water bottle for your child to re-energize before clubs. Please remember that the school is **nut-free**, and parents should be mindful of this policy as if the snacks were being sent into class.

Behavior: Please keep in mind that our instructors are there to instruct, and ensure that the kids are learning and having fun at the same time. Any inappropriate, disruptive or disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated. If your child is reported to the YHPA as being disruptive in any way, you will receive a call or email as a warning. We expect you to discuss this with your child to make sure it does not happen again. If the behavior continues, we will have to dismiss the child from that club. Refunds will not be given if a child is dismissed for improper behavior. Please make your children aware of this policy in advance.

Clubs Dismissal:

Instructors will be wrapping up their club sessions between 4:20 and 4:25 pm, in order to be ready for carpool pick by 4:30 pm.

Please make sure that you arrive at the school no later than 4:25 pm to pick up your children. All of the after-school clubs are run by parent volunteers, who either have children in clubs or who have volunteered some extra time to help make this program successful. We ask that you please be respectful of their schedules and arrive on time for dismissal. If a situation arises where a parent is consistently late for dismissal, a decision will be made on whether or not the child will be allowed to continue in after-school clubs.
